Application Instructions

The WHJA recognizes the importance of extra-curricular and athletic participation for college-bound students and we are therefore pleased to provide this verification of participation in equestrian sports to your high school. We want to recognize high school students who are involved in the WHJA for their participation in and commitment to equestrian sports.

Your active participation in this unique and highly competitive sport will prove to be a positive addition to your college application(s).

Instructions:

1. Complete the application and return it to the WHJA College Bound Program Coordinator once per year. If you would like year-end award information included in your letter, please do not submit your application until after year-end awards have been determined (*except as noted in #2 below*). For purposes of this program, the WHJA will provide equestrian sport verification for members starting with the summer **prior** to freshman year of high school.
2. College applications should be submitted early in the senior year, and therefore, **students entering their senior year of high school should have all materials in no later than mid- September.** We will provide an update to your high school during your senior year upon request.
